

Measure 65.1. Implementing and monitoring the National Strategy for promotion of active ageing and protection of aged persons 2015-2020

- Adopted by Government Decision no. 566/15 july 2015
- Strategic objectives in the field of active ageing:
  - Prolonging and improving the life standard of old persons
  - > Promoting social active and respectable participation of old persons
  - Obtaining a better rate of independence and safety for persons with needs of long time care

#### **Transversal objectives:**

- > Delaying physical ageing and chronic diseases
- > Preparing the medical system to serve ageing population



Operational action plan to implement, in 2016-2018, the action directions stipulated by National Strategy for promotion of active ageing and protection of aged persons 2015-2020

### Priority measures:

- ➤ Consolidating the social protection system to improve the life standard of aged persons, by establishment of a program to support aged population with no income, especially in rural areas (integrated in the **minimum inclusion income**),
- ➤ Changes of human resources policies for a better integration of older workers, inclusing volonteer action programs;
- ➤ Improving skills, employability and independence of older persons, by increased number of counselling and vocational training programs dedicated to older persons, evaluation of the competencies acquired in nonformal/informal system, promotion of mentorship activities, etc;
- > Highlighting a positive image of older population, promoting its involvement in society and social inclusion;
- ➤ Impriving the infrastructure of public spaces in term of accessibility in order to answer specific needs of old population,
- > Preventing abuse on old population and its social exclusion;
- > Creating a unified system of long duration care by establishing a compartment for policies and programs in long duration care within MMFPSPV, regulating the funding system of long duration care, etc.
- ➤ Ensuring financial, human and material resources sufficient for developing the long duration care system, including by implementing the case management for dependent old persons.



### Measure 65.2. Community elders – involving old people in child care programs

#### **Specific objectives:**

- > Developing social services in disadvantaged communities
- ➤ Promoting the concept of active ageing
- > Promoting volunteer activities and encouraging the inclusion of aged persons in these activities
- ➤ Reducing certain social costs
- ➤Increasing the employment rate within old workers (55-64 years, inactive or unemployed)
- > Developing competencies of older workers adapted to the demands

- ✓ Reducing the lack of personnel in social services
- ✓ Reducing the number of aged persons economically and socially dependent
- ✓ Stimulating the employers to hire older workers (55-64 years, inactive or unemployed)
- ✓ Evaluating competencies acquired in non-formal / informal system, envisaging insertion on labour market / inclusion in a continuous vocational training (CVT) program
- ✓ Organization by employers of apprentice programs, participation at vocational training programmes
- ✓ Stimulating mobility for employment



### Measure 65.3. Community multifunctional centres

#### **Specific objectives:**

- > Developing an integrated approach concerning provision of services
- Consolidating the capacity of public services forsocial assistance
- > Increasing horizontal and vertical coordination and step-by-step transition to integrated services
- Estimating costs and allocating adequate budget
- > Devleoping methodologies, protocols and work procedures

- ✓ Creating multi-functional centres
- ✓ Employment of minimum one social assistant in each settlement
- ✓ Reducing the dependency of beneficiaries on social transfers
- ✓ Increasing the weight of social services in the social assistance measures
- ✓ Integrated approach of family needs and of each member's needs



### Measure 65.5 - Financing services of home care for aged persons

#### **Specific objectives:**

- ➤ Regulating, developing and financing a spectre of customized services in order to fulfil the specific needs of aged persons, with focus on **home care system**
- > Developing social services for older people
- > Ensuring care for aged persons in their family environment

- ✓ Developing mixed market of social services
- ✓ Using existing labour force at community level
- ✓ Reducing costs with residential care



# 65.6 Reducing social and family trauma caused by pathology associated to old age

#### **Specific objectives:**

- > Developing medical and social services for old people and their families
- > Awarding more importance to palliative care
- > Developing home care services
- > Reducing the risk of social exclusion for both the aged person and for their family ./ close people

- ✓ Creating integrated services for all communities
- ✓ Increasing the number of home care units
- ✓ Using existing labour force of the community



### **Measure F 6 - Community team for integrated interventions**

#### **Specific objectives:**

- > Consolidating the capacity of public services for social assistance
- > Preventing social risk situations

- ✓ Employing at least one social assistant (higher education) for each settlement, as well as other categories of personnel (in field of: healthcare, education, employment etc.)
- ✓ Using efficient tools to analyse and diagnose in social field and to define the intervention needs
- ✓ Using existing labour force of the community



### Measure 6.1 - School – engine for inclusion in disadvantaged areas

#### **Specific objectives:**

- > Focusing social services around school for members of disadvantaged communities
- > Substituting SPAS and offering information, counselling and social services of healthcare and education to pupils and their families

- ✓ Consolidating the role of school in disadvantaged areas
- ✓ Increasing the level of education and school training
- ✓ Prevention of school leaving
- ✓ Reducing the risk of social exclusion
- ✓ Qualified labour force



# Measure F14. Strategic map of social services and of the need for development and providing of social services

#### **Specific objectives:**

- Ensuring a **coordinated and evicence-based approach** in the elaboration and implementation of policies, programmes and interventions oriented to vulnerable persons and to the poor and marginalized areas;
- > Implementing a decision-making process within MMFPSPV and at local level, based on information obtained through rigurous methodology, fundamented empirically, based on evidence and statistic data;
- > Developing and using a set of standard instruments fo planning and provision of social services at local level in order to increase the quality of public services;
- > Training the specialised staff, at central level, and at the level of local public authorities regarding public policies oriented to the citizen and other themes of interest

- ✓ Reduction of disparities of development between more developed and marginalized communities.
- ✓ Planning social services in time and formulating measures with more accurate potential impact
- ✓ Diversification of types of social services offered at community level based on real needs.
- ✓ Avoiding long term costs of social risks to which marginalized persons are exposed
- ✓ Elaborating instruments that will be the basis of local/county/national strategies to develop social services



### Measure T3. Digital alphabetisation of persons in marginalised communities

#### **Specific objectives:**

- Connecting people to knowledge-based economy and to social e-services and preparing conditions of social innovation
- Implementing the concept of e-inclusion by expanding the network of Points for Public Access to Information (PAPI).
- ➤ Increasing access to IT&C technologies
- > Creating digital competencies for disadvantaged persons
- > Increasing the rate of using electronic services for public interest

- ✓ Avoiding long term costs of social risks to which marginalized persons are exposed
- ✓ Reducing disparities of development between most developed and marginalized communities
- ✓ Increasing litteracy within vulnerable persons
- ✓ Increasing access to IT&C technologies
- ✓ Improving the rate of using electronic services for public interest
- ✓ Educated and productive labour force.



### Measure F12. Healthcare in rural areas

#### **Specific objectives:**

- > Developing medical and social services for persons in rural areas
- > Reducing the risk of social exclusion caused by medical affections
- > Increasing the role of prevention and the importance of education for healthcare
- > Reducing costs for treatment in hospitals

- ✓ Establishing integrated services for all rural communities
- ✓ Using the existing labour force within the community
