Saint-Gilles, one of the 19 municipalities of the Brussels Capital Region One of the poorest municipalities in Brussels:

- near the canal and the old industries
- > near the Midi station

Average revenue below average for the Brussels region 48% of people of foreign origin









Social coordination - social networking

- The social action policy of the municipality is built through its own means, but also and in some areas especially through the mobilization of federal, regional and community resources.
- •More than 100 associations, competent in the social field, work in Saint-Gilles.
- •The Commune and the CPAS are active directly or indirectly to carry out a policy of social action aimed at the population as a whole (children young people adults the elderly) and in all areas that affect the daily life of citizens, for example: Housing employment health local justice social cohesion sport culture ...







Networking in Saint-Gilles, a long story

• Since the 1980s: the spontaneous meetings of social workers present on the territory and supported by the President of the CPAS at the time: Albert Eylenbosch.

The CPAS is a key player at the local level acting within a legal framework:

That allows him to accomplish his missions in a curative, preventive and palliative way.

Who defines mandatory missions:

- As the granting of an integration income (or its equivalent) allocation granted in a residual way (for people with no access to any resource).
- This grant is generally linked to a contractual approach with the user. It aims at social integration through social and / or socio professional remobilization.

This legal framework also gives the CPAS the opportunity to create specific projects aimed at its population through its local expertise.

For this purpose, the CPAS has the tools to create and coordinate social projects and establish partnerships.

It is this opportunity that gives him the opportunity to expand his social action missions outside and in addition to his mandatory missions.

In view of the need for coordination of social actions on the ground and given the missions of the CPAS, on December 18, 2003, the Common Community Commission took a college meeting a decree on the granting of grants to Public Centers for Social Action as an intervention in the costs related to social coordination

This decree fully meets article 62 of the law of 8 July 1976 organic Public Centers of Social Action:

"The CPAS can propose to the institutions and services deploying within the centre of the social activity or specific activities, to create with them one or more <u>committees</u> where the centre and these institutions and services could coordinate their action and confer on the individual needs or collective and the means to respond to it "







Social Coordination

Purpose and Objectives

The purpose of this networking is to fight together against social exclusion

The objectives set up then on three main poles still relevant

- > To get to know each other better and to decompartmentalise the work of social organizations operating in the municipality and to develop synergies
- To set up, when the associative medium wishes it, a place of speech and reflection on problems, gaps which exist today at the social level on the territory saint-gillois
- Together, carry out projects to overcome these problems, formulate proposals that social coordination can transmit to the public authorities







The Social Action Coordination Service of the CPAS Saint-Gilles started on April 1st, 2004

The idea is to try to create a "social link", that is to say, to allow local operators to come together and consider together (and initially informally) possible and realistic solutions to specific issues

The objectives are to include the social coordination of Saint-Gilles as being "the" place of exchanges and debates of local institutions and associations operating in the field of social action







The stages of creation

- Individual contact with the actors in the field (the census already existed)
 - Offer of the CPAS Networking Service
 - Proposed gathering of observations and problems of each
 - Identification of the main themes of social action
- Organization of a first assembly
 - Work in thematic workshops with actors in the field
 - Highlighting the need to work from now on each month in thematic working groups







The stages of creation

- Creation of working groups (Housing, Migration, poverty-health, Youth and Access to culture)
- Realization of a common charter highlighting the main principles of a democratic social coordination
- Election of a representative and decision-making body of social coordination representing the members (having signed the charter): The accompanying committee.
- General meetings of the members (associations and public services) to present the works and reflections of each others.







And today

- More than 100 members (associations and public services) participate in social coordination meetings
- 10 thematic working groups (+ 15 members of different services within each group): Housing, Health, Migration, Youth, Childhood, Early Childhood, Senior, Insertion, Culture, Homeless.
- Social coordination lunches, meetings with partners
- Multiple projects, actions, awareness campaigns and creation of tools (information brochures ...) and even services were born from the reflections and proposals of this social coordination.







And today

Better knowledge of the actors in the field



- Better orientation of the public towards the services most likely to help them
- Recognition of coordination by land actors and public authorities
- Listening to these observations and recommendations
