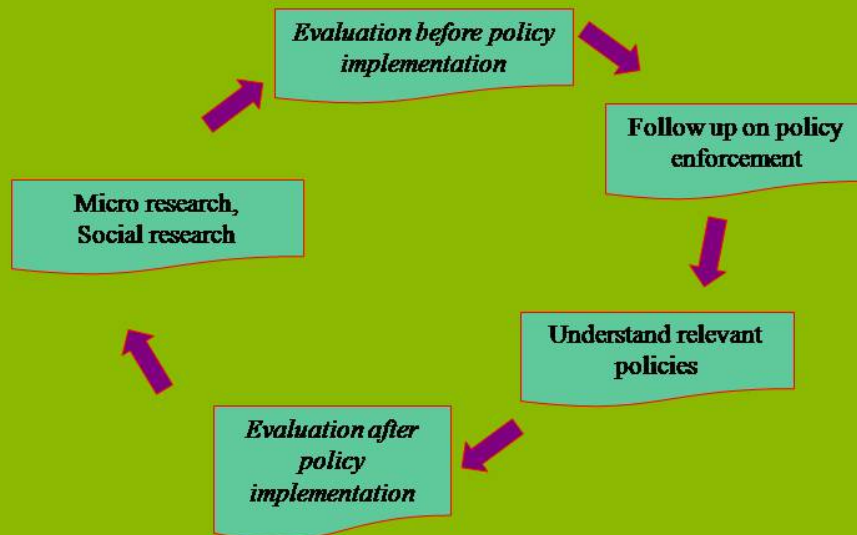




Micro research and social research

- **Scientific articles :**
  - youth
  - public expectation to public policy
- **Research study :**
  - child care
  - need of parents
  - job related to child care
  - service
- **Survey :**
  - method of child care (nursery, babysitter, etc.)
  - housing
  - social minima beneficiaries
  - Impact of divorce (education method, child care expenses, asset heritage, etc. )
  - Method of taking care of children after divorce (parent take turns; focus on children's position)
- **Conduct a regional diagnosis**



Evaluation before policy implementation

- 
- **Through the evaluation before policy implementation :**
    - Recognize the impact of the reform
    - Recognize the relationship between different mechanisms
    - Design the scope and intensity of the measures in a more precise way
    - But it is hard to evaluate (it is hard difficult to predict public behavior, speculation is requires)

*eg: the income condition for family allowance, the increase of family supplementary allowance, the establishment of employment bonus and the increase of Dibao*

- **tool**
  - Static and dynamic standard case model
  - Micro simulation with internal data
    - Micro simulation mode
  - Adopt research and survey result

Follow up on policy enforcement

■ **Establish database**

- Identify the data needed to be tracked (the amount of allocation, material, expenditure, etc.)
- Ensure the rationality of data
- Establish standard data sheet

■ **Follow up on policy enforcement**

It is a special work, not on a regular basis

- Tracking report
- Evaluation report before implementation and tracking report
- The report is only for internal use, and it should be submitted to senior administration department or published

Understand relevant policies

■ **Adopt internal information system, which involves different aspects**

- beneficiaries (ALLSTAT, FILEAS, BENETRIM, ALLNAT)
- service (EAJE, ALSH...)
- service relationship
- expenditure (the collection of expense)
- third party
- allocation payment (reminder, data mining)

■ **Conduct annual social action survey**

- family mediator
- REAAP, CLAS, AAD...

■ **Conduct survey to understand the ultimate beneficiaries**

- FILOUE pilot (popularizing)
- PAJE mini nursery survey

■ **Diagnosis, standard indicator**

- child reception places (ONPE, Imaje)
- percentage charges
- EAJE child reception

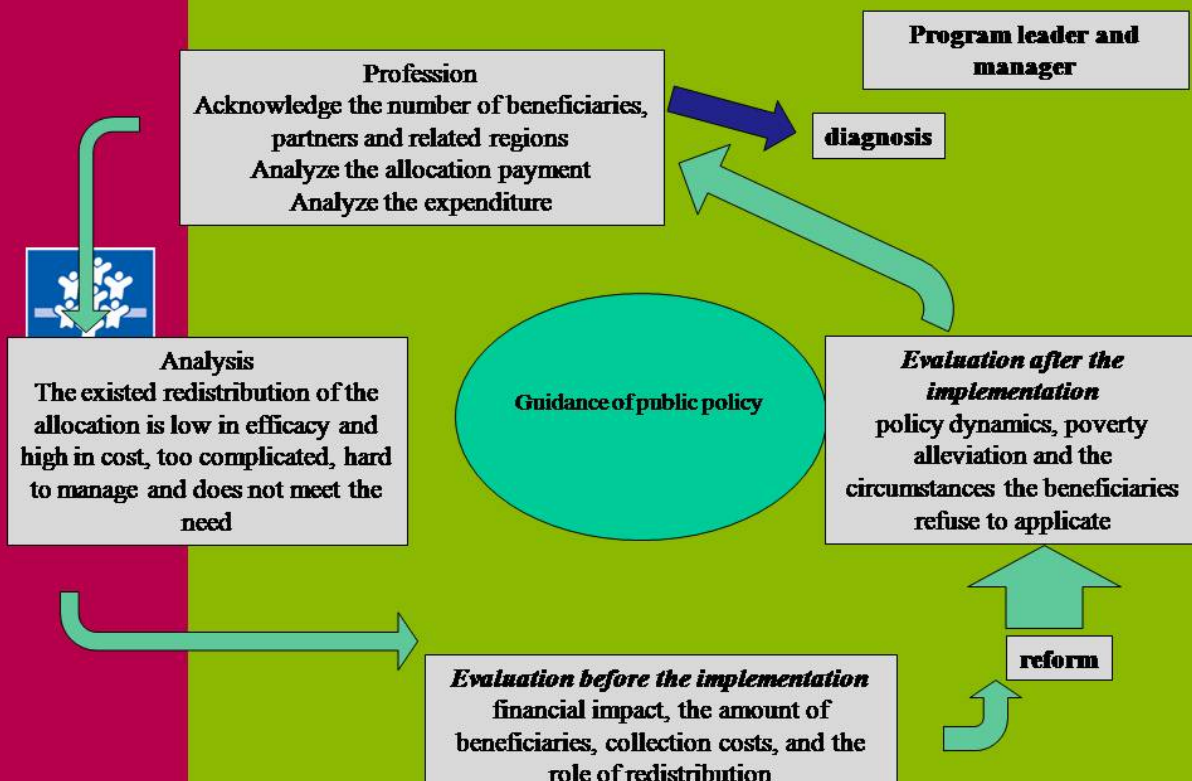


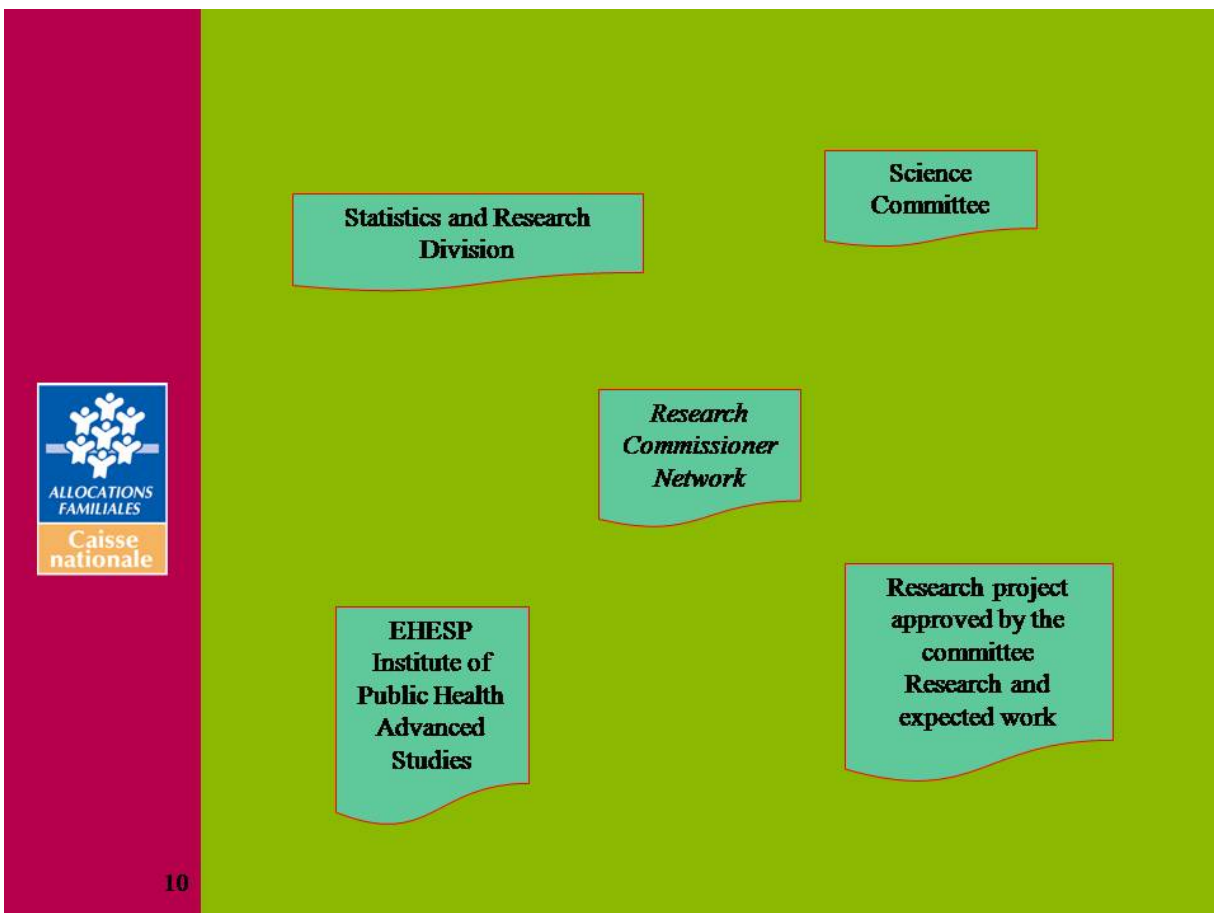
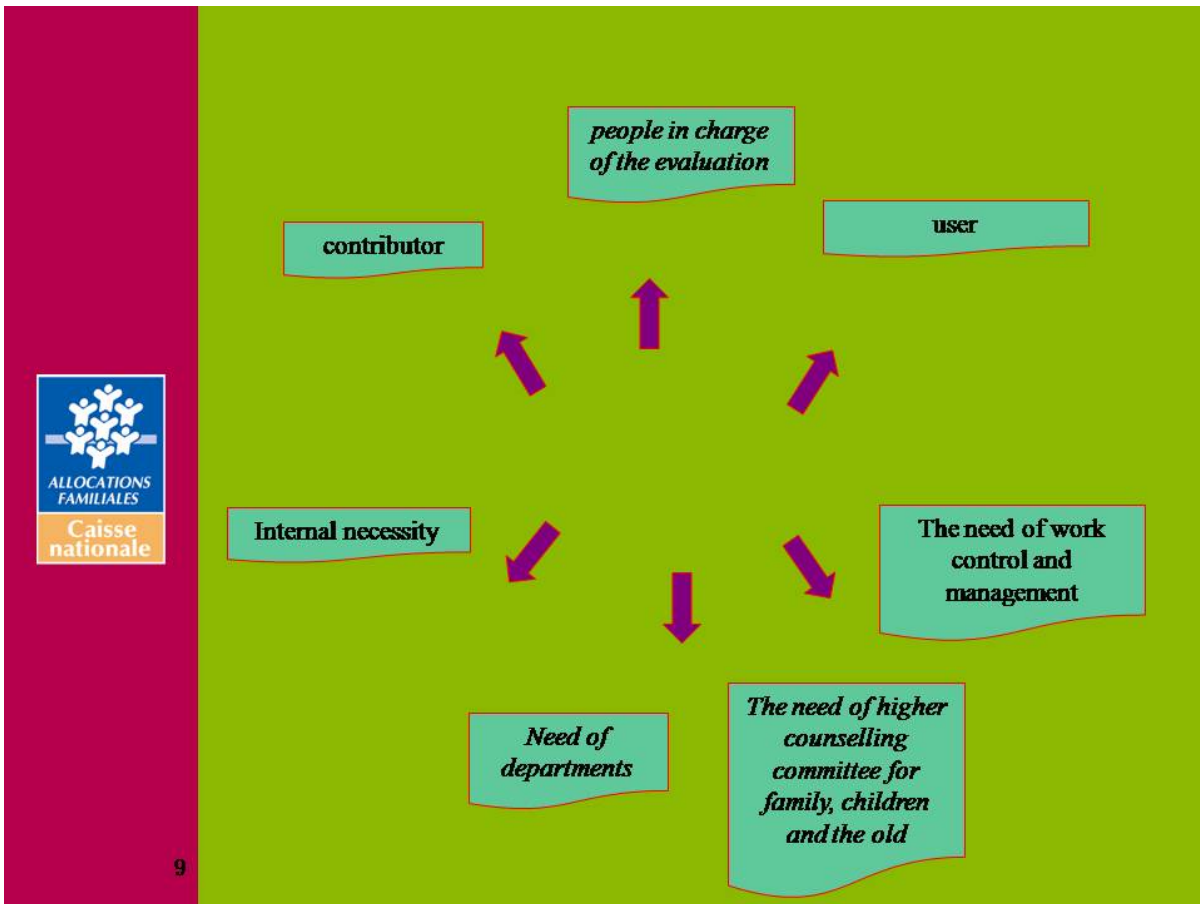
*Evaluation after policy implementation*

- **The review after policy implementation involves different aspects:**
  - Beneficiary (the amount, redistribution)
  - Finance (the impact of implementing Paje on revenue)
  - The potential beneficiaries do not apply (RSA, automatically communicate with the General Director of Public Finance)
  - Increase reception places in EAJE child reception centers
- **Conduct survey, about:**
  - Employment bonus
  - Accommodation of youth workers
  - Longitudinal research results of French children with ELFE
- **Research study:**
  - Include fathers into CLCA (If the father choose to quit job to take care of his child, he should receive income allowance)
  - Understand the reason for not applying for allocation
  - RDDE
