Goal of Family Policy



- ▼ Cover some expenses related to children
- Help fragile families
 - Poverty alleviation work
- Balance family life and career / promote children's social development
 - Provide high quality child reception service
 - ▼ Parental leave
- Help parents do their parts: recently carry out parent companionship policy
- => Expenditure related to family assistance accounts for 4 % of GDP





A comprehensive set of services

- Services include:
 - Family fund allocation
 - Social work
 - Provide fund for organizations and institutions (social reception centers, nurseries, children's entertainment center, etc.)



Parenting education

- Provide child fund allocation for families with child under three (12 billion euros)
 - Newborn bonus: Provided to those in line with the revenue condition. Such families can receive 923 euros when their children were born.
 - <u>Basic allocation:</u> It is linked to revenue, with the highest of 184 euros and the lowest 92 euros.
 - <u>Parenting education allocation</u> (Prepare): Each parent can receive this allocation for at most 24 months. It is designed to help partents who temporarily quit their jobs (390 euros) or reduce working hours (252 euros) to take care of their children.
 - <u>Supplementary allocation for caring the child:</u> This allocation aims to afford the expenses of hiring child-care assistant.
- **2.8** billion euros has been invested in 12 000 nurseries
 - Fund expenses on investment and operation
- Of every 100 children under 3 years old, there are 56 reception places (among them 33 places are for childcare assistants)





Policy related to children and teenagers

- Three kinds of fund allocation
 - Family allocation (12.5 billion euros)
 - Related to income, not limited to low income
 - Families with two or more children enjoy family allocation until the eldest child reach 20 years old
 - The amount of allocation for family with two children: 129 euros/65 euros/32 euros (according to income)
 - <u>Family supplementary allocation</u> (2 billion euros)
 - Help families with more than three children
 - Has income on-line and is related to income
 - Schooling allocation (2 billion euros)
 - Has income on-line. The amount is determined by the age of children (6-10 years old: 364 euros)
- Children entertainment center(after school and during holidays) (1 billion euros)
- Fund allocation for holiday travelling(60 billion euros)

Accompany parents to ensure they perform their responsibilities

- CAF provides comprehensive services with 100 million euros:
 - Help parents improve their relationship, improve the quality of family
 life and children education as well as support innovation program
 targeted at parents (support institutions which organize supportingparent groups, parent universities and "family plan" developed by social
 reception centers)
 - Strengthen the ability of parents to support their children's studies
 - Establish the relationship between family members and support the development of parent-child reception center
 - Prevent the risk of broken family and help separated parents to improve the living capability
 - Promote information to families (design the official website monenfant.fr, distribute brochures on "first newborn" and "parent of adolescent child")







Measures on poverty alleviation

- Active solidarity income RSA (10.8 billion euros)
 - · Minimum revenue guarantee linked to family structure
 - . Limited to adults over 25 years old or under 25, yet with a child
 - eg: A single parent with one child can receive 800 euros
- Employment bonus (3.2 million beneficiaries, 4.7 billion euros)
 - workers over 18 years old
 - The higher the revenue, the less the bonus. This allocation is for supplementing job revenue.
- Housing allocation
 - 18 billion euros, 6.3 million families receive housing allocation
 - 27 % of families with children can receive housing allocation
- Allocation for the handicapped (adult and children)
- Allocation for the handicapped adult: 9 billion euros
- Education allocation for the handicapped children

Accompany parents who have broken up or are separating

- Organize consultation for "separated parents"
- fund family mediation service
- family support allocation:
 - Provide fund to single parent
 - The allocation aims to supplement child-care expenses (the amount is low: the minimum guarantee is 104 euros/children)
 - Help single parents who raise orphans or do not have access to childcare expenses
 - The amount reach 1.5 billion euros
- help collect child-care expenses
- Support parent-child meetings to maintain the relationship between a child with his/her parent without custody





Social companionship service

- Personalized companionship service
 - Accompany vulnerable families that experience major events (separation, funeral, newborn and unemployment, etc.)
 - 2 400 social workers
 - 375 000 events need to mobilize social workers
 - Provide consultation, guidance and companionship.



Avoid the situation that potential beneficiaries do not apply for allocation

- Simplify the procedures
 - Reduce the amount of necessary materials
 - Target at 100% paper-free
 - Assist families with digital tool
 - ▼ Further communicate with partner organizations:
 - o Simplify administrative procedures
 - o Find enjoyable allocation
 - o Improve allocation management=security
- Simplify related laws and regulations
- Provide consultation and guidance
 - ₹ 250 000 interviews had been settled in 2016
 - Establish the official website Le caf.fr, design promotion activities and allocate simulator, etc.
